Types of Diagnostic Testing

Our team conducts three main diagnostic screening tests to help us detect, manage, and track your pet's overall health.



Blood Tests

A complete blood count (CBC) is crucial for understanding your pet's health, revealing signs of infection or blood disorders. Blood test are essential for detecting diseases transmitted by ticks and mosquitoes, such as heartworm disease. Additionally, we conduct blood chemistries on every pet to evaluate kidney and liver function, promoting comprehensive health monitoring.



Fecal Testing

Fecal testing tells us if your pet has internal parasites such as roundworms, hookworms, whipworms, and tapeworms. These parasites can become a problem to people too!



Urinalysis

A urinalysis shows your pet's overall kidney and bladder health. By testing the urine, we can determine if your pet is suffering from kidney disease, bladder crystals/stones, or a urinary tract infection, to name a few.
